ABOUT TIGHT LINES FOR TROOPS

Now in its 9th year, Tight Lines for Troops (a federally recognized nonprofit organization) proudly announces its 9th Annual Fishing Tournament for Michigan Veterans. The event will again be located at the First Street Boat Launch Area in Downtown Manistee. We are pleased that this prominent area at the end of First Street has become the “forever home” of the Tight Lines for Troops event. All activities will be held under the large tents in this location including the registration and Friday Mandatory Meeting, as well as those which take place after a day of fishing on Saturday. The fishing boats will be located at the Manistee City Marina in Downtown Manistee. We believe this will provide increased opportunities to interact with the local community, who have consistently honored and supported our veterans and this event in prior years.

The 2018 boat fleet consists of approximately 50 big lake fishing boats, and several boats accustomed to providing a river fishing experience for those who are interested. Again, the host committee will offer a Pier/Shore division for those who wish to fish from the shore. In all, the 2018 Tight Lines Fishing Tournament will deliver a memorable experience for approximately 250 Michigan Veterans, most of whom have not yet had an opportunity to attend and participate in this outstanding event. Those who receive “boarding priority” are WWII and Korean War vets, POWs, Purple Heart recipients; then any Veteran of any branch of service and select active duty service people.

Though the fishing tournament itself is limited to registered participants, the public is invited to join the “Welcome Back Celebration” as the boats return to the marina, traveling up the river channel to the City Marina. The Riverwalk along the river channel will be lined with patriotic and appreciative fans, waving their flags to cheer and welcome the fishermen back “home”. In expressing his gratitude for the event one previous participant said, “When I came home from duty, we were told not to wear our uniforms. The people were tired of Southeast Asia. Thank you for honoring these great men and women for their service. I was honored to be part of the day.” Another participant shared these feelings: “This is the Welcome Home I never received. After all these years, I cried because I didn’t realize how much it meant to me. I was proud to take part.” Every year we are moved by these same types of comments. Be a part of the Celebration and join us on the Riverwalk for the Flag Welcome!

The success of this program is a result of the collective efforts of over 500 sponsors and volunteers. Veterans pay no charter fees or entry fees. It is with great pleasure and honor that we all look forward to hosting the 9th Annual Tight Lines for Troops Fishing Tournament for Michigan Veterans on May 19th, 2018.
